

REP Volunteers

We depend on parent volunteers to assist us during class times. All volunteers must have gone through the "Protecting God's Children" course, available ONLINE through the Rockford Diocese web site: www.rockforddiocese.org.

Adult classes are offered through the Elgin Deanery for catechists to enhance their knowledge of the faith. We expect all catechists to attend at least one of these classes during the school year. Other volunteers on this sheet are invited to take advantage of this as well! (All fees will be paid by our REP office.)

Catechist

You will teach the Faith to our students! You must be active participants in the sacraments, have been Confirmed, and at least 21 years of age. Materials and resources will be available to you to enhance your lessons.

Catechist Aide

You will help the catechist in the classroom. You will deliver the attendance sheet to the office, collect homework, and assist with class projects.

Substitute Catechist

You will be contacted if one of the regular catechists is unable to teach class. Teaching materials will be picked up at the parish office or directly from the catechist a few days before class.

Office Parent

You will fill out tardy slips, receive the attendance sheets from the aides, and help make copies. You can bring your iPad, knitting, or a favorite book to read while you cover the office.

Attendance Parent

When the attendance sheets have all been returned to the office, you will track down any students who are missing that have not been called in as absent.
